2. MODALITIES

TWO DIFFERENT MODALITIES CAN BE TAKEN

MODALITY. 1

INTERPRETER PROMOTION PROGRAM

Classes and activities that students receive or participate in:

- 4 monthly individual instrument classes.
- 4 monthly orchestral repertoire classes.
- 4 classes and rehearsals with accompanying pianist.
- 4 types of chamber music class.
- 4 classes per month of ear training and analysis.
- 1 orchestra simulation per month. Simulation of tests to access orchestras and competitions.
- 1 performance and staging per month.
- 1 monthly recital. Students must perform a monthly recital in public.
- 1 participation with orchestra practices each quarter.
- 2 English classes (if you do not have the required level and it is necessary)
- 2 hours per week of physical training for musicians.
- 1 Study room.



Therefore, students will receive weekly individual instrument classes, chamber music, orchestral repertoire, class with accompanying pianist, auditory training and analysis, English classes, and physical training. Likewise, monthly you must take the simulation test to access the orchestra or competition (depending on the specialty) and perform your recital. Every quarter he will perform a concert with the orchestra.

You will always be accompanied by your personal tutor and the psychologist specialized in high performance in music.

The guidance department will present you with different selection proposals to perform concerts in the venues indicated below, in addition to the different tests to access orchestras and competitions around the world.



MODALITY. 2

MEETING PROMOTION PROGRAM

In this modality, a minimum of three meetings per course and 24 online instrument classes are held throughout the year. Students will receive 4 hours of face-to-face classes in each meeting. At least, you must attend one of the planned in-person meetings. At the same meeting he will participate in the concerts with the orchestra.

This modality has the same participation options in the continuous selection of performers who will perform concerts around the world. The selection tests will be carried out under the established conditions.

Activities and rooms for 2024-25 where students who achieve the planned objectives will be able to perform concerts.





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

All registered students will participate in this contest. The winner will receive a €6,000 scholarship for the best performance. It will be held in Valga (Galicia) in person. The contest rules will be provided to all students once registered.

4. RECORDING OPPORTUNITY

THE RECORDINGS WILL BE MADE WITH TOP-LEVEL ORCHESTRAS IN VIENNA, LONDON, MILAN, CROATIA AND HUNGARY.

Students who present sufficient talent may be selected to record with orchestras around the world. The price is not included in the Promotion Program and will be informed for each project, as it depends on each orchestra and the number of sessions necessary.

The recordings will be made with toplevel orchestras in Vienna, London, Milan, Croatia and Hungary.

Admission. All students must be admitted to the Promotion Program. It will consist of three tests: a) Initial and informative interview: Once this interview has been passed and all the information has been received, if the student is suitable, the rest of the tests will be taken.

- b) Practical test: Test where the student will present several works of different styles. The admission team will give you all the information necessary to present them.
- c) Final interview: If the student has passed the two previous tests, he/she will move on to this last test.

All registrants will be given the results in writing.


